

Example of a Lesson Plan for Intermediate Level

- Today's date on board
- Greeting
- Ask students what today is and point to date on board (to be answered in a sentence)
- Go over homework (if any) – This serves as a review.
- Pronunciation – letter student is having difficulty with
- Appropriate level reading selection from a book you have chosen for your student. If you want, you can check books out from Lincoln Literacy library.
 1. prepare with new vocabulary (5-7 new words)
 2. Exercises in comprehension (in book)
 3. Discussion questions (in book)
 4. Exercise in writing
- Assign homework.

Students should be taught slowly. Lesson plan may very well extend to the next meeting.

As you teach you may find you need to stop and spend time teaching another point.

Ex.: Your student may write "I had *to* much to eat." You would take the opportunity to teach "*to, too, two*"
