## Getting Started

To become a student with us is easy.

**First**, call us for an appointment.

**Second**, at your appointment you will meet with a staff member. The staff member will test your reading ability. Don't worry about the test. We help students at all levels, from beginning to advanced.

**Third**, although our group classes are free, you will pay a one-time \$20 assessment fee for one-to-one tutoring. That is the only fee we charge. You may also have to buy a book for your studies.


*If you cannot pay the fee or buy a book, you can apply for a scholarship to reduce the cost.*
